1 The minutes of the last meeting were read.

2 Matters arising

Bank Account Update and Amendments - Frances Waberski is to get forms for Beverley Howes and Simon Faulks to sign and become signatories on the account.

General Data Protection Regulations – Residents have been contacted seeking permission to retain and use their email addresses for contact by the Parish Council on matters which may concern/ interest them. Several replies have been received. The Parish Council has been registered with the General Commission and the Direct Debit form sent off.

Potholes in Bretingby/ Wyfordby – most of the potholes along the Main Road in Bretingby and Wyfordby have been repaired.

Hedges along Lag Lane – Thorpe Arnold PC is to be contacted and asked if they can do anything about getting the hedges up Lag Lane cut back as they are dangerous and complaints have been received.

3 Broadband Speeds - A representative from Buckminster Broadband attended the meeting and gave a talk about the availability of their Broadband service within the Parishes.

4 Accounts 2017/ 2018 – The Accounts have been internally audited and a Certificate of Exemption sent to the PFK Littlejohn. The accounts for the year have therefore satisfied all the statutory requirements.

5 New Local Plan – There is a meeting on 15th October from 6.30 – 8.30 pm in the Council Chamber in the Melton Borough Council Office on Parkside.

6 Speed cameras – An email has been received from Leicestershire County Council advising us that the speed cameras will very soon be installed on the B676.
